Qualifications to enter Working Trials Stakes

Instructions:

1. Find the Stake you want to enter down the left hand side.

2. Then look across the row to see which qualifications are required, and which qualifications debar you from entering this Stake

E = You cannot enter the Stake on this row if you already hold this qualification

You need this qualification to enter the Stake on this row. Except where shown for WD Champ, you need all the ticked qualifications

 \checkmark = You need to have gained this qualification on at least two occasions

• You cannot enter a WD Championship Stake and a TD or PD Championship Stake at the same Trial

• You can enter an eligible dog in both the Introductory Stake and the CD Open/CD Championship Stake at the same Trial

Open: Cert Merit - a Certificate of Merit is gained at an Open Trial where the dog has gained at least 70% of the marks for each group of tests **and** has gained 80% or more of the total overall marks

Champ: Qual - A dog qualifies at a Championship trial where it has gained at least 70% of the marks for each group of tests but has not gained 80% or more of the total overall marks

Champ: Ex - a Championship 'Excellent' is gained at a Championship Trial where the dog has qualified by gaining at least 70% of the marks for each group of tests **and** has gained 80% or more of the total overall marks

EXAMPLE: To be eligible for WD Stake at a Championship Trial, the dog must have qualified Excellent in a CD Stake at a Championship Trial, **and** qualified Excellent in a UD Stake at a Championship Trial, **and** have either gained a Certificate of Merit in a WD Stake at an Open Trial or have qualified Excellent in a WD Stake at a Championship Trial. However it ceases to be eligible once it has qualified Excellent in a TD Stake at a Championship Trial.
