Kennel Club Obedience Regulations G paragraph 32 – Minimum judging experience required for Championship Class C at Championship Obedience Shows.

On a person's first appointment to judge Championship Class C the minimum conditions which apply are:-

- must have at least eight years judging experience which must include 30 Championship and/or Open Show appointments of which at least 15 must be Open Class C and two each of Beginners, Novice, Class A and Class B.
 - must have been assessed by a Kennel Club approved assessor.
 - must have attended a Kennel Club Obedience Regulations and Judging Procedure seminar and passed the Obedience and Judging Procedure examination.
 - must have attended an Obedience Test Design and the Practice of Judging Seminar (effective from 1 January 2015)
- 2) The person must have been assessed when judging Class B or Class C by a Kennel Club approved assessor. NOTE: A Judge may only judge one Championship Class C (Dog) in any calendar year, and may only Judge one Championship Class C (Bitch) in any calendar year.
